. The Rwanda Sisterhood Association – RSA

After the terrible 1994 Rwandan Genocide, a women's support group, The Rwanda Sisterhood Association, RSA, was set up. The RSA is run by women. It supports women in Kigali to be self-sufficient helping them to learn new skills and to earn an income. It also runs a nursery school and a nursery for toddlers so that parents can look for work each day.

The RSA also supports new mothers, protecting them and their new-born infants by providing "Mama-Packs" which contain everything needed for a safe birth. The 79 baby blankets knitted by people in the Parish of St Mary's with Coleshill, and shipped to Rwanda, are part of this important project.

Our parish community is still knitting. Thank you very much.
