

PUBLIC WORSHIP AS A RESULT OF 8 DECEMBER 2021 ANNOUNCEMENT

- Pews and other seating arrangements have been restored to where they were pre-pandemic, except that at St Mary's, social distancing has been maintained in St Catherine's Chapel. For those who have concerns about maintaining social distancing, there are cards that worshippers can use to request others to leave space next to them free.
- Those attending services are asked to use the NHS track and trace QR code and app as it will continue to form one of the main ways of identifying people who may have been exposed to coronavirus.

It is now mandatory unless people have an exemption to wear face coverings in public worship. This does not apply to those leading worship or doing readings. Whilst face coverings may be removed during singing, we suggest that they continue to be worn

- Communion will continue to be offered in one kind only, the bread.
